The First Presbyterian Church of Bryan is pleased to invite you to join its 2018 Peru Mission Challenge Trip – May 18-27, 2018

Where is the 2018 Mission Team going?

Team members will fly from Houston to Lima Peru, proceed to the ancient Andean capital of Cuzco and travel by private bus to their home base in the city of Quillabamba (“The land of perpetual summer”).

What will Mission Team members do?

- Learn about Peru’s history and geography, see archeological treasures, experience its customs, culture, and foods;
- Help complete work on a multipurpose facility for large group gatherings and retreats;
- Assist with the delivery of health & wellness, and clean water workshops;
- Lead art, music, puppet, exercise/sports programs for children;
- Medical professionals: triage, medical assessments and delivery of services;
- Spanish speaking team members are needed to help with translation.

Who can participate? Individuals 18 years + who enjoy good health, have a servant’s heart, a spirit for adventure and a desire to experience new cultures. For applications, contact the Peru Mission Coordinator (*see below*) or find applications on the Mission Board next to Associate Pastor’s office (Room 9) across from Pastor Ted’s office (Room 6).

Submit your application and deposit by April 1, 2018.

What will it cost to go on this mission trip?

While FPC Bryan will cover the-cost of in-country transportation, lodging and meals, for FPC members, all participants are responsible for approx. \$1,500 in expenses for:

- A \$250 deposit must accompany all applications to secure a place on the Mission Team;
- Round-trip airfare between Houston and Lima Peru (approx. \$1,000-\$1,200);
- Passports, required/recommended vaccinations, medications or emergency medical procedures (*trip insurance is recommended*);
- Personal purchases & side trips that may be taken after the mission work is completed.
